

Concordances

Concordances are lists of where every major word appears in the Bible. Pick a word, look it up, and see a verse-by-verse listing of that word (often with a little surrounding context, in case you are looking for a specific phrase). It is important to use a concordance that is based on your preferred translation to avoid confusion when possible.

One helpful feature of printed concordances is that many of them will also include the reference number for "Strong's" Hebrew & Greek dictionaries. This will let people get into some of the differences and nuances of the original languages even if they don't even understand their alphabets.



Leviticus 27:34, handwritten Hebrew* from 10th century:




Leviticus 27:34, modern digital Hebrew* lettering:
