30 Day Reading Plan

Highlights from the Gospel of Luke

There are roughly 1,151 verses in the Gospel of Luke spread out over 24 chapters. That means that if you want to go nice and slow through the Gospel of Luke at the rate of 10-12 verses a day (reading about one story a day), it'll take around 100 days to complete this book. If you use this plan along with my study guides, you'll cover several stories already. This plan focuses on taking readers through 30 "highlights" from the book, cutting it down to just 1 month for reading.

If you're looking for a simple way to get something meaningful out of your daily readings beyond just gaining information about ancient stories, one suggestion is to take a few moments and journal your personal reflections around these 4 items:

S: Scripture. Write down your favorite verse from this story. (Maybe this would make a good verse to memorize...)

O: Observations. Write down the facts that you notice about the story. It might be something said or done.

A: Applications. Write down how the story applies to your own life. These are your personal lessons.

P: Prayer. Write out your prayer based on the story. It might mention your observations or applications, and might be appreciation for what God promises or a request that God helps you grow and improve.
